

Application for HKBU CIE AD--Sport and Recreation Studies (SPRS) (2025/26 admissions)

Applicants applying for Sport and Recreation Studies (SPRS) are required to upload the following supporting documents via the CIE Online Application System **NOT LATER THAN two weeks after application submission**. Any late submission will not be considered.

(A) Documents showing fulfillment of admission requirements:

- 1) 2025 HKDSE Local Applicants (before HKDSE results release):
 - Predicted HKDSE results report issued by the secondary school; and
 - Academic reports of Form 5 and Form 6 issued by the secondary school.
- 2) Non-2025 HKDSE Applicants:
 - HKDSE results notice or certificate.
- 3) Other Qualifications:
For example:
 - High school academic report and graduation certificate;
 - Results notice or certificate(s) of any public examination(s);
 - Academic transcript and graduation certificate of the programme;
 - Certification on acceptable qualifications.

(B) Supporting documents for sports achievements and qualifications:

For example:

- Records of sports achievements (e.g., medals, trophies);
- Certificates of participation or awards in sports events;
- Letters of recommendation from coaches or sports organisations;
- Membership certificates from sports clubs or associations;
- Any other relevant documentation showcasing your sports qualifications.

(C) Self-introduction video:

Each applicant should produce a self-introduction video with the following requirements:

- The video should be a continuous, unedited introduction of the applicant.
- The applicant's face (either facing the camera or in profile) should be visible throughout the video.
- The recording should be within 3 minutes.
- The video should only include the applicant.
- The applicant should speak in English.
- Video content:
 1. Introduction (1 minute):
 - Introduce yourself and provide your full name.
 - Provide the reason(s) why you choose the College of International Education (CIE) and Sport and Recreation Studies (SPRS).
 2. Questions (2 minutes):
 - Answer 1 to 2 of the following questions:
 - a) Describe a recent news about sports and share your view towards the news.
 - b) What specific areas within sports and recreation are you most passionate about?
 - c) What skills do you believe are essential for success in the field of sports and recreation?
 - d) What is your articulation or career plan after completing this programme?
 - e) Share one of your most memorable experiences in your sports life.
 - You may also share study or sports-related topics other than the above-mentioned questions.

The applicant should upload your video via YouTube platform (set the link as unlisted in visibility) and share the link via the CIE Online Application system.

Note:

The College may view your video via YouTube platform in or before September 2025. The applicant may remove the video from YouTube after October 2025.
